

TIPS FOR PHOTOGRAPHERS

1. We aim to produce an interesting exhibition of diverse images from different perspectives of life in PNG.
2. Subjects are not limited, so can be from traditional or modern PNG life, rural or urban, landscape or portrait, people or animals. All are acceptable as long as they have a distinctly PNG feel to them. For example, a picture of your cute puppy on the lawn will probably be of no interest as it could come from anywhere. On the other hand, a picture of a cute puppy being carried in a bilum, may be of interest because it is identifiably PNG.
3. Painted faces, traditional bilas and 'festival' images are all welcome. However bear in mind that these are very popular and we will only be choosing the best ones. We recommend using a different subject for at least one of your selection of 3 entries.
4. Images of naked children will not be printed, and we ask that you do not submit them to the Facebook page.
5. Images of a distressing or pornographic nature will not be printed, and we ask that you do not submit them to the Facebook page.
